## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Acting under the authority of the Ohio Revised Code Sections 119.03, the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board hereby announces a public hearing will be held on Friday, July, 20 2018 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board room, 1929 Gateway Circle, Grove City, Ohio. This is a statement of the agency's intention to promulgate the following rules:

### New Rules:

- **4709-3-08:** Assistant barber teacher  
Being proposed to create the requirements for an assistant barber teacher license.
- **4709-5-01:** Reciprocity  
Being proposed to replace existing rule 4709-5-01 with a clarified requirements for the recognition of licensure from other states and jurisdictions.
- **4713-1-16:** Abandonment of applications  
Being proposed to create a process to abandon application pursuant to term of incompleteness and type of application.
- **4713-1-17:** Fees  
Being proposed to establish fee for cosmetology and barber licenses, permit, and registrations.
- **4713-19-15:** Temporary chemical tanning facilities  
Being created to create a temporary tanning facility permit for services provided in locations other than fixed premises on a temporary basis.

### Amended Rule

- **4713-21-06:** Applying for inactive licensure status and temporary work permit  
Being amended to move language to new rule 4713-1-17.

### Rescinded Rule

- **4709-5-01:** Reciprocity  
Being rescinded due to proportion of rule change. New rule proposed.
