## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON PROPOSED EXECUTIVE ORDER ON ADVANCED PRACTICE TRAINING PROGRAMS**

Dear Director:

Soon after Am. Sub. S.B. 213 was signed into law, the Board recognized critical issues that needed to be addressed to implement provisions of the law related to the newly created advanced practice license. These were:

- (1) Transitioning currently approved “Manager” training programs to “Advanced” training programs on the effective date of the new law (September 13, 2016);
- (2) How to recognize training completed by graduates of a “Manager” program prior to September 13, 2016, who could not take or did not pass a qualifying manager examination prior to September 13, 2016; and
- (3) How to recognize hours earned by students currently enrolled in an approved “Manager” training program for continuance into an approved “Advanced” training program; and

To address these issues, the Board proposed amendments to its current rules. These rules are going through the normal rules filing procedures. This is a lengthy process and it could take up to four months to complete. To effect these changes on September 13, 2016, the Board has filed three emergency rules, which are being considered by the Governor’s office. If approved these rules will do the following, pending the final filing of the permanent rules:

- (1) Manager training program curriculums approved by the Board on or before September 13, 2016, shall be changed and recognized by the Board as advanced training programs after September 13, 2016;
- (2) Clock hours earned prior to September 13, 2016 in a manager training program approved under Section 4713.30 of the Revised Code effective prior to September 13, 2016 will be eligible for continuance into an approved advanced practice training program; and
- (3) Individuals that complete a managers training program approved under Section 4713.30 of the Revised Code effective prior to September 13, 2016, will be eligible to take the advanced practice examination for the branch of cosmetology studied.
